I am seeking your input on a significant new whole-of-government project. The myWA Alpha site ([alpha.wa.gov.au](http://alpha.wa.gov.au)) was launched last week, and is the first step towards making government services easier to access online for the WA community and businesses.

MyWA is part of the State Government's ICT Strategy, *Digital WA*, which sets out a roadmap for how government agencies can use technology to deliver better services to the community.

People want more convenient access to government services, and the long term vision for the myWA Program is to deliver a digital "one stop shop" where the community and businesses can find and access online government services in the one place.

The myWA Alpha site is a prototype intended to obtain public input into the final design, content and functionality. We want to create a site that is tailored to the needs of the community and businesses, and reflects modern service delivery arrangements.

The myWA Alpha site will stay live through the first half of 2017, and be updated regularly in response to feedback.
