

The Department of Training and Workforce Development (the Department) assists apprentices and trainees with travel and accommodation related costs for their off-the-job training component when you travel more than 70 kms to a registered training provider (RTO).

Check your eligibility
You are eligible if you:
☐ Have a residential address in Western Australia;
☐ Attend off-the-job training via a RTO;
☐ Travel by private vehicle, bus, train or plane (minimum round trip distance limits apply);
☐ Travel to the closest RTO available; and
☐ Are an active or suspended apprentice or trainee.

From 1 July 2023, apprentices will receive increased per-kilometre and accommodation rates when claiming the TAA for off-the-job training that commenced after 1 July.

Lodge your TAA claim online within 60 days of completing your off-the-job training.
