## **User guide for contracted providers**

## The preferred provider panel lists

Registered training organisations (RTOs) who are contracted by the Department of Training and Workforce Development to deliver funded vocation education and training in Western Australia are registered on preferred provider panels for the program(s) they successfully applied for.

At no cost, contracted RTOs can advertise through the Department the qualifications they are contracted to deliver under the programs on preferred provider panel lists. RTOs delivering in more than one program can advertise on more than one preferred provider panel list.

Preferred provider panel lists are advertised to the public on the Departments Jobs and Skills WA website.

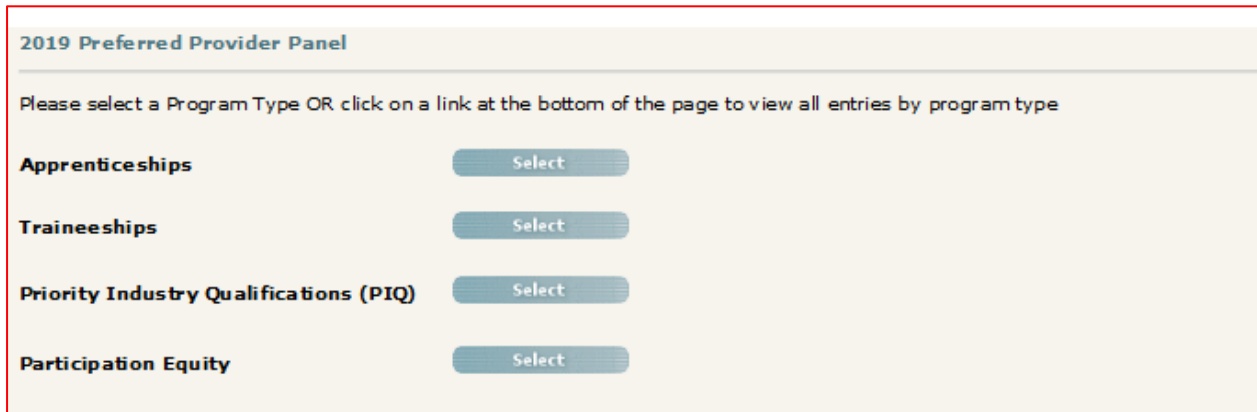
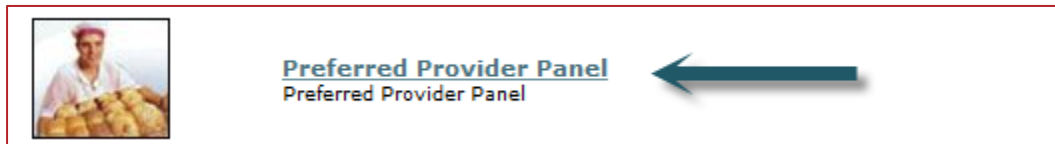

The preferred provider panel lists are located on the Departments State Training and Recognition System (STARS) and are updated nightly.

### 3. How can I advertise on a preferred provider panel list?

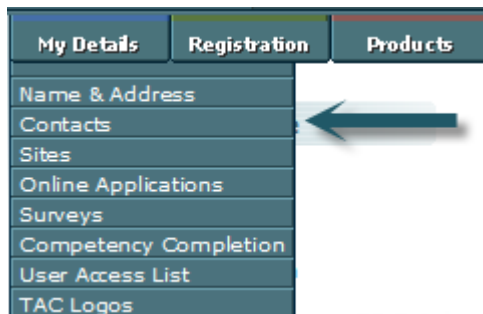

To advertise on a preferred provider panel list for the above programs you must register a contact person for the advertisement with the Department.

Once a contact person has been registered, the Department will advertise all of the qualifications you are contracted to deliver under the program(s) on the preferred provider panel list(s). To advertise only some of the contracted qualifications, refer to part 4.

To register a contact person you must;

- I. Access RTO-Net on <https://stars.dtwd.wa.gov.au>
- II. Select 'My details' in the tabs and open 'Contacts'




III. Either create a new contact  or edit an existing contact 



IV. Select the 'Contracted Provider List (CPL) role



V. Nominate the program(s) this person is to be the contact person for and click ;



## TRAINEESHIPS

To advertise on the preferred provider panel for the traineeships program, training providers must complete two stages;

- 1) Register a contact person (refer page 5 for process)
- 2) Nominate the qualification(s) and region(s) you would like to advertise delivery in;

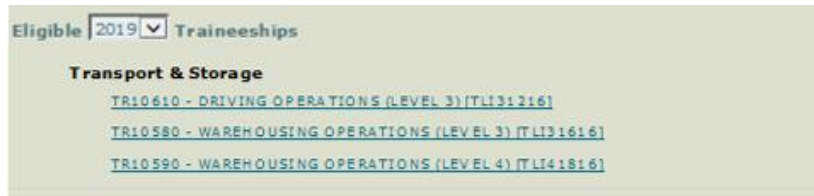
To nominate a qualification and region you must;

- I. Access RTO-Net on <https://stars.dtwd.wa.gov.au>
- II. Select 'Contracts' in the tabs and open 'Training Provider List'



- III. Select 'Maintain Traineeship Contracted Provider List (CPL)'

A list of your qualifications on scope for the current calendar year will appear



IV. Open the qualification you want to advertise (each listed qualification is a hyperlink)

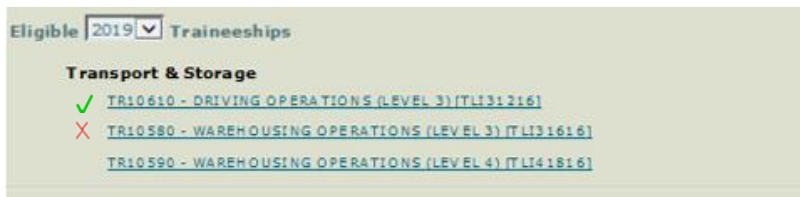

 Successful: A green tick will appear next to qualifications successfully placed on the preferred provider panel list.

 Unsuccessful: A red cross will appear next to qualifications which did not succeed in loading onto the preferred provider panel list. You will need to click on the qualification to see why it was unsuccessful.

To remove all/some qualification(s) from the traineeship preferred provider panel list you must open each individual qualification in the contracted provider list on RTO-Net and un-tick the regions you no longer wish to advertise delivery in. To remove the qualification entirely you must un-tick all regions.

**Important note:** *The preferred provider panel lists are updated nightly. Any changes you make will not appear until the next day.*
